



Why Are Knowledge Organisers Important?

Our children need to know things; lots of things Geography, Science, Art, Technology, Religion etc.



Knowing things helps them to know more things.
The more they know the easier you can learn something new.



What your child needs to know by the end of every topic is organised into their Knowledge Organiser.



Learning this knowledge means it has to be stored in their long term memory so it can be recalled and used at a later date; sometimes at a much later date!



In order for this knowledge to be remembered we need to give the children the opportunities to recall what they know. This is particularly important for children with additional needs.



We will give regular opportunities for children to remember that facts on their knowledge organisers either through a quiz, missing word games, labelling pictures etc.



You can support your child to learn the sections of the knowledge organiser given for homework.
Ask them what they have learned and what they can remember.
